### WHY WE PARTNERED

Smart Havens Africa presented an exciting partnership opportunity for Reall. Their green credentials are impressive, with houses constructed using compressed earth bricks which, as well as being affordable, are made using minimal cement and require no firing. Brick production is a major source of CO2 emissions and pollution in Uganda, so this product has the potential to provide an affordable and green alternative.

Underpinning their commitment to green building is an emphasis on social impact. Smart Havens' target market sits firmly within the bottom 40% of the income pyramid. They are also dedicated to women's empowerment. Smart Havens prioritise female-headed households in the sale of their houses, and also provide much needed training and employment opportunities in construction to local women.





## BUILD & BROKER

**BUILD:** Smart Havens are looking to scale up to building 10,000 affordable and climate-smart homes per year from 2026.

**BROKER:** Smart Havens' innovative compressed earth bricks are new to Uganda and have the potential to transform the country's material supply chain with their affordable and green credentials. Smart Havens are increasing the likelihood of this by training a growing base of construction workers to use the material.
